## Pastor's Corner

We see in today's readings how all who are well disposed to the love of the Lord and are willing to follow His most loving commandments will realize salvation through Him. Peter learns in the First reading that our faith movement is not just for Jews but also for gentiles. All people of good will are welcome to participate in the life of the Church.

Jesus wants us all to be happy and in order to be happy we must love as He loves us. As well as our Second Reading from 1 John today, we might well turn to St. Paul's First letter to the Corinthians, 13. I advise all of us to read this passage again and again until its contents are written on our hearts. It speaks of that true, good love of neighbor which will make both happier and holier for having experienced it.

Jesus wants our joy to be complete and it will only be so when we have truly embraced God's love for us and work on our love for Him and our neighbor. We learn how to love from our parents who teach us by word and example how to follow joyfully the commandments. On Mother's Day then, let us appreciate the love we have received and make sure it is well used. Happy Mother's Day and God bless you all.

## Stewardship Reflection

St. John calls us to love in the second reading and this love, as is that we receive from God is self-giving without expectation of a return. It is the kind of love God feels for us. Too often we may do something with the expectation of getting something back. To practice stewardship in a pure sense, we need to love the way God loves us. That is central to what John is trying to teach and explain to us. You may have heard the expression "God is love" before; however, we must accept that love, and we must commit ourselves to loving in the same way. If we do that, God's love through us can transform not only us but also those around us.
