Pastor's Corner

Although the word "Trinity" is not actually used in the Bible, we do see emphasis on God as Father, Son and Holy Spirit and the earliest Christian symbols attest to that. The gospel is Jesus' commission to the apostles to make disciples of all nations in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

We are in awe of God of course and the Trinity is mystery. How then could we ever approach such a God? How could such a God ever approach us? Well, the Father –Creator God – approaches and is approachable through the beauty of His Creation. The Son, in his incarnation, makes us closer to God as a perfect version of ourselves. The Spirit is the love shared by Father and Son evident in our good relationships. Yes God is approachable and He is near. He is close to us as Abba, Father, as Saving Son and as uniting Spirit. Stewardship Reflection

It is the Triune God who leads us through the Holy Spirit to repentance, to truth, to love, to holiness, to stewardship. It is through pursuing this life in the Spirit that we are able to serve God and one another. The Gospel from Matthew, even though not lengthy, contains Jesus' complete call to us to "make disciples of all nations." Disciples are made through teaching and through conversion. To be a Christian steward involves a conversion of the heart and mind.

As indicated in our U.S. Bishops Pastoral Letter on Stewardship, "Jesus' call is urgent. He does not tell us to follow Him at some point in the future but here and now, at the moment, in our present circumstances." The Bishops later say in that letter, "The life of a Christian Steward, lived in imitation of the life of Christ, is challenging, even difficult in many ways. But both here and hereafter it is charged with intense joy."
