As you read this I should be in England with one of my sisters and her family, putting on weight and enjoying the lazy life. Let's hope the weather doesn't let me down and that the terrorists stay at bay. Next week we'll head to Ireland for the traditional celebration of Cemetery Sunday – when we honor our dead. It is more joyous than it sounds. I hope all of you are alive and well when I return.

In today's Gospel Jesus teaches us how to pray and His prayer, the Our Father, is central to the prayer life of any Christian. Really the Our Father is a summary of all prayer; the various petitions sum up all the themes of prayer. We don't, by the way, tell God what he needs to know but our prayer helps us to know ourselves and our true needs better. This prayer assures us that we will receive what we ask for, if for our good, and the process will direct us to a type of spiritual life where we develop a sense of priorities and learn what is worth praying for.
