Pastor's Corner

This weekend we celebrate the beautiful feast of the Epiphany when three foreign dignitaries came from afar to worship humbly before the Christ Child. This of course demonstrates to us that all people of goodwill are embraced lovingly by God – all are His children. The gifts they brought were significant of course but most importantly it was their doing the Lord homage as the King of the Universe. The Church, and we her members, must be seen as truly Catholic i.e. truly universal

Our bishops have asked us to mark this day as Immigration Sunday. The US is a country formed on immigration and yet so many are fearful of or antagonistic towards people from other lands, especially these days those from Mexico and the Middle East, Jesus' home region.

In this country we have recently witnessed a resurgence of this xenophobia because of the Muslim situation. If our Catholicism means anything we must view the human family as a whole, people made in God's image. We might recognize this even in people who do not express explicitly Christian belief. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

The importance of Epiphany is that the Magi from the East were most definitely Gentiles. Yet, they, representing all of us to a certain extent, recognized, accepted, and acknowledged Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. The Epiphany brings us all into the fold in terms of Jesus' divinity and saving grace. St. Paul makes it clear in today's reading, as well as in his letter to the Ephesians (who were also Gentiles), that "Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise of Christ through the gospel." We must recognize that all peoples are made in the image and likeness of God and live out our lives of stewardship accordingly.
