Pastor's Corner

Jesus and the Samaritan woman meet at Jacob's well in this week's gospel. The place unites them historically as the well was established before the divide between the Samaritans and the Judeans. However, the divisions had occurred and the woman did not want to give Jesus water because of them. Jesus says that He is what should unite because He is the very "water of life."

There are often divisions between us and other people, even between ourselves and God and so reconciliation must be sought. If we could only see that Jesus is the living water and that He won life back for us at a terrible cost. He is always available to us and we should look inside ourselves and realize that He is the only living water so necessary for life.

Once Jesus had opened the door as it were to a spiritual discussion he won the woman over and she became something of an apostle. Her life had changed and she felt truly alive. Left to ourselves life would just evaporate but with him inside us, we have a fountain of water which surges up and nourishes all that is good within us – we are truly alive. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

In today's first reading the people turn against Moses, but he does the right thing. He turns to God in his need and appeals for the Lord's help. Moses places his total trust in God, and the Lord provides. We need to do the same thing if we are to be productive stewards. If we trust in God implicitly we are well on the way to happiness.

The Samaritan woman learned from Jesus that God loves us where we are and with all of our faults. However, we should confess those faults and repent of them and receive the grace we seek. This brings us peace and it brings us happiness. We just need to trust and persevere and believe and we can attain the happiness and hope promised to all true disciples.

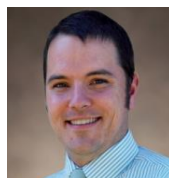
