Pastor's Corner

Lent for most of us is at once a pilgrimage; a retreat, a time of self-scrutiny and confession and a time of doing penance for sins committed. The gospels of Matthew and Luke give us the three temptations of Jesus in the desert but Mark merely tells us that he was tempted, after being driven by the Holy Spirit into the desert. Jesus is the suffering servant of course who in His baptism took on the sins of the world and in his suffering and death strips away those sins.

After John's arrest Jesus begins His ministry and, like John, He will call us to "Repent and believe in the Gospel." We should, with God's grace, strive to do that during Lent. Our prayer and penances of fasting, abstinence and almsgiving will help us. We are called to "turn ourselves around." We are called to a conversion of the heart. Jesus is with us through baptism and our Lenten penances can be signs not only of conversion but also of our realization of the meaning of our own baptism. I wish you well on your Lenten journey. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

There are more than 700 references to water in Holy Scripture, but as we begin our Lenten journeys, our concentration needs to be on our own Baptism and our personal Baptismal call. Stewardship has been defined as our response to that Baptismal call through discipleship and service. Just as Jesus entered the desert for 40 days, we are doing the same during Lent. Defining our Baptismal call is part of what we should be striving to do at this time. Baptism calls us to a sense of mission. God has blessed us with much but we are mandated to use well what he has given. We are called to share with others and to support our Church. We are called to use responsibly and fairly our time, our talent and, yes, even our much valued treasure.



Stations will be prayed at both of the parishes throughout Lent. Wednesdays at St. Bridget's at 5:30 pm, and Thursdays at St. Bernard's at 6:30 pm (come early for soup supper at St. Bernard's).
