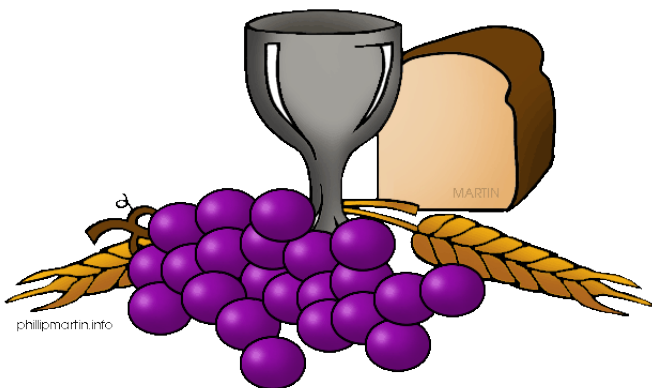
Pastor's Corner

In today's first reading from Ezekiel, we see how God would take a cutting from the tree of the Davidic dynasty and plant it in Israel where it would grow majestic after the exile in Babylon and when the restoration would come. Though the world, represented by Babylon and Egypt looks as if it rules supreme yet they would be humbled and Israel would grow taller.
