## Pastor's Corner

Jesus "loved" the man in today's Gospel who ran up to him, being effusive and overwrought. Jesus loves us too. Sometimes we may have trouble with this concept because perhaps we fear some aspects of ourselves. Many of us may have a hard time loving ourselves, thus making it harder to accept love from Him and others. The consequence: difficulty in loving Him and others and ensuing sadness.

If we understand the invitation Jesus gives this man, and if we accept what he sadly rejected, we will find ourselves transformed by love. We will find love to be our greatest treasure in fact. This will help us to detach ourselves emotionally from our wealth, our earthly possessions. We might "let go" of the material world around us and risk, as it were, on behalf of the Kingdom of God which provides happiness in surprising ways.

## Stewardship Reflection

Jesus reminds His followers in today's Gospel that, as demanding as following Him and leading a Christian life may be, "all things are possible for God". • Our task is to pray, to seek what the Holy Spirit is leading us to do, to search for guidance through the Word of God, and then to commit ourselves not only to living as we should as good stewards, but also to incorporate our Savior and His Word into our very hearts.
