He is the son of Dennis and Amy Edholm. The *Pillars of Faith – Duty to God* is a special recognition given to Catholic Boy Scouts who have earned all four of the Cub Scout and Boy Scout religious emblems - Light of Christ, Parvuli Dei, Ad Altare Dei, and Pope Pius XII. This award represents that the four religious emblems are like pillars supporting the Scout's development in his Catholic faith, his "duty to God". It is awarded by the Winona Diocesan Catholic Committee on Scouting. Only 4% of all Boy Scouts earn their Eagle Scout award, and this award is significantly rarer than that. Congratulations, Jacob!
