Pastor's Corner

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi aka "The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ." The Feast has been celebrated by the Universal Church since around 1317 and is focused solely on the Holy Eucharist - unlike Holy Thursday which includes the institution of ordination and emphasis on service to God's people.

While the bread and wine do serve to bring a community together to share a holy meal, the Eucharist is not simply made up of symbolic actions and the species do not simply remind us of the paschal mysteries – they RE-present the paschal mysteries. Christ is truly present when Mass is celebrated by a validly ordained priest.

Jesus promised to remain with us always and He keeps that promise primarily through the Eucharist. Our belief in His real presence in the bread and wine is at the core of our Catholic Faith. The Mass is the highest liturgical expression of this. We should be aware that, as salutary as the practice of Eucharistic adoration might be the primary reason for the Eucharist is that it be the food and drink of the faithful. Let us consume the Lord's Body and Blood this weekend and realize what a great gift we are receiving. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

In today's gospel, before He feeds the people, Jesus does the following: "Then taking the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, he said the blessing over them, broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the crowd." We may think in terms of Jesus blessing the food before He distributes it; however, there is more to it than that. Jesus was also blessing God for supplying the food. Before we receive the Eucharist, we need to do the same — thank God for blessing us with these gifts. We show our gratitude to God through lives of stewardship, lives of loving and caring and sharing.

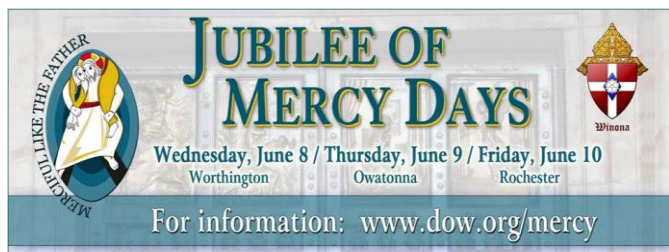
