Pastor's Corner

In today's first reading we see David making a series of sinful decisions culminating in his adultery and his setting up of Uriah to be killed in battle. Murder! However, we also see David's repentance and God's mercy, though sin has its consequences and David would be punished. David returns to the way of the Lord and is a good king thereafter as he tries to make amends for his betrayal.

This reading complements the Gospel passage about the woman who washed and anointed Jesus' feet. This shows grateful love coming from the woman who had been a notorious sinner but whom Jesus shows tenderness, love and mercy to. This shows how the one who is forgiven many grave sins is the one who will experience great joy at having been forgiven. Let us think of our own sinfulness and let us remember David and this woman as we continue to celebrate this "Year of Mercy." God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

In today's 1st and Gospel readings we see how two people, David and the woman who have sinned against God are forgiven and how they celebrate by performing good works in thanksgiving.

God is always ready to forgive us, but we need to find the humility and the obedience to seek and receive that forgiveness. Humility is such an important part of living stewardship as a way of life. It is that humility which allows us to see our weaknesses, and to know that it is only through a loving God that we can be forgiven, and thus strengthened.
