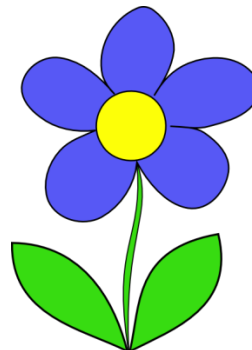
Our Parishes & Other Notes
