## Pastor's Corner

Today's gospel is rather odd. It might seem that Jesus is praising the Dishonest Steward for his dishonesty – but he isn't. He is simply saying that we disciples must deal with our spiritual lives with every bit as much conscientiousness, take it as seriously, as he did things of the material world. We must recognize that life here is temporary and that we must work constantly and consistently to ready ourselves for the eternal life that is to come.

Bishop Robert Morneau in his pastoral letter *Stewardship: A Disciple's Response*, wrote 'on Judgment Day, the Lord will only ask us one question, "What have you done with the garden I have given you?" In other words, we are all gifted, perhaps in different ways, but whatever gifts we receive might be considered our garden from God. We must account for those gifts. This is what is meant by taking discipleship and spirituality seriously. God bless you all.

## Stewardship Reflection

The whole concept of stewardship is clear in today's parable. The steward is the manager (not the owner) of the master's gifts. God is, of course, the manager, and we are the stewards who are charged with the responsibility of overseeing our gifts of time, talent, treasure, and perhaps even influence. Do we use those gifts wisely and with justice?

Our Holy Father Pope Francis once commented, "In the end, everything has been entrusted to our protection, and all of us are responsible for it. Be protectors of God's gifts." As the Lord says to the steward in today's Gospel, "The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones."

**Bishop's Special Blessing:** Bishop Quinn will acknowledge and give a special blessing to our catechists when he comes to bestow Confirmation on our youth. Your valuable work throughout the year is greatly appreciated.
