Pastor's Corner

"If they will not listen to Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead." This Sunday 25 of our young people will be confirmed by our bishop, John M. Quinn. He will bestow upon them the seven gifts of the holy Spirit and these, if used, will help them greatly in their faith as adults of the Church. However, although the gifts will be bestowed and confirmation a fact whether they believe or not, in order to really benefit from these gifts they must be open to the Spirit of God. Confirmation is bestowed to set afire the deposit of faith in these young people so that they will not be indifferent and complacent but ready to use their gifts to spread the life and the love of the gospel.

So it is with all of us. We have been educated in the ways of faith for several years and have the wealth of the gifts of the Holy Spirit within us but unless we are truly open, unless we use what we have received our faith lives amount to little or nothing. In the gospel, Jesus is trying to emphasize to us what it means and what happens if we are indifferent and complacent. The Lord never condemns the rich man for his wealth, but He does condemn him for not caring, for ignoring and neglecting those in need around him, in this case poor Lazarus. We are called to believe but we are called also to act upon that belief with the help and guidance of the Holy Spirit. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

We all have a choice in life, just as those highlighted in today's readings. The Rich Man chose selfishly and suffered the consequences. He was indifferent to the needs of others as exemplified by his attitude towards Lazarus. We can be satisfied and choose to remain ignorant and removed from the needs around us, or we can love as Jesus wishes, follow Him, and be disciples.

Jesus expects each of us to shepherd those we love and those with whom we come in contact. We use our time, our talent and our treasure to accomplish this on earth. Being a disciple, a true steward, entails action. Stewardship means action, not just sharing, but sharing openly and actively.
