Pastor's Corner

Psalm 95: "If today you hear His voice, harden not your hearts." Well it seems that the Apostles did hear His voice and responded not only appropriately but quickly. They dropped everything to follow Jesus – and for those working in the fishing industry, or like Matthew our author who was a tax collector, that probably meant a good deal. It would certainly mean placing family and friends and businesses etc. lower on their list of priorities and giving up their own way of doing things in general - their own agendas therefore.

How do we respond to Jesus' call - how should we respond? Do we really give even of our plenty in terms of our time, talent and treasure in service to the Lord? Do we find excuses not to? Do we procrastinate? Do we leave it to others? If Jesus is indeed the herald of the great God proclaiming the kingdom of heaven, shouldn't we listen with great care and respond accordingly? Stewardship Reflection

A key part of our Gospel Reading today is the onset of the Lord gathering His Apostles, as He initially calls Peter and his brother Andrew, closely followed by the brothers James and John. It is important to note that their response was immediate: "At once they left their nets and followed him (Jesus)." There were no debates, no discussions, and no long considerations. That is a great example to us. Do we hesitate; do we wait to become a disciple of the Lord? We really should not. If we accept Him as our Savior and as the cornerstone of our Church, our response, too, should be immediate and definite. We are called to be good stewards of the Lord's Church and of our faith communities.
