## Pastor's Corner

*Passover 2017 begins on the evening of Monday, April 10 and concludes on the evening of Tuesday, April 18. Thinking of the celebrations of Palm Sunday and Good Friday we must state the following from the USSCCB:*

"The message of the liturgy in proclaiming the passion narratives in full is to enable the assembly to see vividly the love of Christ for each person, despite their sins, a love that even death could not vanquish. The crimes during the Passion of Christ cannot be attributed indiscriminately to all Jews of that time, nor to the Jews today. The Jewish people should not be referred to as though rejected or cursed, as if this view followed from Scripture. The Church ever keeps in mind that, his mother Mary and the Apostles all were Jewish.

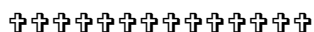
As the Church has always held Christ freely suffered his passion and death because of the sins of all, that all might be saved."

## Stewardship Reflection

Any reflection offered on this day pales in comparison of the true Words we hear in the Passion. There is neither time nor space to offer a complete reflection on what we hear. Therefore, it might be best to focus on the one aspect of the Lord's humility.

The Lord's humility is shown throughout the Passion, but not just during the Passion, but throughout His entire life. This was a man, yes, but He was also God. Yet, His love was boundless and His humility is so obvious. If we are to be true disciples, true stewards that should be our concentration as well, especially during this Holy Week we are beginning. If we can love in some small way as Jesus has loved us, and if we can seek and find even an iota of the humility He shows, we will indeed be on the path to holiness.
