Pastor's Corner

Jesus Christ is Risen Today – alleluia indeed. This is the Church's biggest feast and we have had six weeks of Lent to prepare ourselves for it. We now put behind us, for a while anyway, the immense suffering by Christ that led to this great victory over death and try to get caught up in the joy of this most vital in terms of salvation. We should carry this joy from Mass to our celebrations and our lives.

All of the Gospels tell of the Resurrection of Christ. They may differ in some details, but they all agree that Christ is Risen. The Apostles will now go forth to spread the Good News, helped of course by the later descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. They speak of His Resurrection, not the empty tomb. The Resurrection opens the doors of Paradise to all who believe and who are willing to become a New Israel, a New Creation. That is what we need to do, what we need to share — the Easter joy of being a Catholic Christian. A Happy Easter to you all.

Stewardship Reflection

Easter for us should be an encounter with the Risen Lord. We are to share the Good News. That is what Mary of Magdala does. Perhaps we have a difficult time talking about the joy we feel at Easter and at other times in the Church. We should not be hesitant; sharing the joy is part of being a disciple of Christ; it is what makes us an "Easter people." The use of our stewardship is a way of sharing the new life God has given us and we do this with humility. May we be reinvigorated by the power of Easter and be truly those who do all "for the greater Glory of God" (Ignatius Loyola)

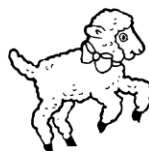
