## Pastor's Corner

Our first reading today from Isaiah anticipates the coming of Christ and John the Baptist as it proclaims, "... prepare the way of the Lord." This is a time of preparation for us. Preparing that path may not be easy but it is necessary. The most important thing is to accept Christ as the way, the truth and the life - and John as His herald.

Today we see the beginning of the Good News according to St. Mark. John the Baptist did not look much like good news as he was roughly clad and roughly spoken but his words and his manner hit home for many. If we are genuine and sincere about proclaiming Christ's truth in a spirit of love, God will give good fruit to our efforts.

Christ will return in glory one day and we should not become discouraged. Let us continue to prepare for Christ's coming by renewed faith, hope and love. God bless you all.

## Stewardship Reflection

God is waiting for us. St. Peter in his Second Letter, from which our Second Reading is drawn, indicates that God, however, "is patient with you." You might say on this Second Sunday of Advent that the Lord is giving us a second chance to respond to His call. One of the basics of St. John the Baptist's messages was that we need to get ourselves right with the Lord, perhaps turn our lives in a different direction. We can change; now is the time to do that. We are called to be good stewards and to prepare for His return with good words and works and a fullness of faith.
